## **Should I apply for Low Cost Spay/Neuter Assistance?**

If any one of the following applies to your family, complete an Application for Low-Cost Spay/Neuter Assistance, attach proper documentation (applicant's name must be on documentation) and deliver to the address on the top of the form.

- We receive assistance from a Provincial or Federal agency. If so, attach a photocopy of one of the following:
  - Current letter from your Social Worker
  - A current Client Reporting Card
- We are low income but not on Social Assistance. If so, present any of the following at time of Application:
  - Income Tax Documents
  - Employment Insurance Documents
  - Workers Compensation Documents
  - Pay stubs from your place of employment

Application can be made at any time during the year, as long as funding is still available.
